Program Objective

Patient Care Technicians (PCT) are integral members of the healthcare team and work with doctors, nurses, and other healthcare professionals to oversee and monitor patients. As a vital member of the healthcare team, they provide direct patient care such as, but not limited to taking vital signs, specimen collection and comfort measures. In addition, Patient Care Technicians are trained in phlebotomy and electrocardiography. Salary ranges for PCT's range from \$14.00-\$16.00 per hour.

Admission Requirements:

- Possess a high school diploma or GED certification
- Criminal background check
- Health Screening, including TB skin test
- Flu vaccination (during applicable semester)
- Drug screen
