Here is how the program works and how to apply.

PURPOSE: To provide funds to the selected recipient to attend any accredited associates or bachelors degree producing school.

ELIGIBILITY: Any member of the 2^d Cavalry Association, all active duty soldiers in the 2^d Cavalry Regiment, their family members; children, or grandchildren of 2^d Cavalry Association members are eligible to complete for this scholarship as well. <u>Applicants must have been accepted to attend or are currently enrolled in an appropriate school at the undergraduate level (Incoming Freshman or Sophomore, Junior or Senior year of Study).</u>

PROCESS: Applications must be submitted to: dragoon67@verizon.net not later than 15 June 2015. The cover email must include the applicant's name, address, telephone number and how he or she meets the eligibility requirements. The applicant must also submit an essay selected from one of the topics below. This must be formatted as a MSWORD document with one inch margins double spaced using Garamond 12 point font, not exceeding three (3) 8.5 x 11 pages and sent as an attachment to the application email. The essay should have no identifying marks such as names so that it may be judged by a blind panel. Applicants must choose one (1) of the following Topics:



- The United States military is the most respected institution in the United States. Why is that?
- What is the "Profession of Arms"? Why is it important to our society?

EVALUATION AND AWARD: The winner(s) will be announced on or before 15 July 2015. The scholarship funds will be deposited with the appropriate institution prior to the start of the 2015 - 2016 academic year.
