Stop Being Afraid -- How To Fix Things

Saturday, June 4 1-3:30

For all of you who live in terror of dropping stitches or purling instead of knitting, and so on. We can help. We'll also talk about how to add features to garments when you're all done – including adding or subtracting length. Requirements: Bring a 20-stitch, 5-inch swatch in stockinette stitch in which you knit one right-side row (maybe an inch from the top) in ribbing (K1, P1) – and in which you drop one stitch in the last row. Pre-register, but you can use any yarn.

AND ... On Sunday, August 14 The Fabulous Ellen Minand

Ellen creates all of that gorgeous hand-painted yam we've heaped up on the display just as you come in the door at Ellen's Half-Pint Farm in Norwich, Vermont, will teach an ALL-DAY hand-painting course. You will leave with at least one skein of your own yarn, done in YOUR OWN COLORWAY, designed in conversation with Ellen. More undyed yarn will be available, should you wish to make more than one -- but a skein of fingering weight yarn comes with your tuition. We also provide dyes and other materials, plus lunch. We'll begin at 9:00 AM and continue until we're done, or until 5:00, whichever comes first. We have not yet firmed up the price. But stay tuned -- and call us NOW if you want to be included. We will have to put a cap of 12-15 on this one.
