How does the 'Recipe for Success' program work?

The Girl Scouts experience empowers girls to discover, connect and take action by being a part of a troop that participates in activities that teach leadership and skill development. Afterschool sites are a natural fit for the Girl Scouts program. In conjunction with the SC Afterschool Alliance, the Girl Scouts are offering a special opportunity (exclusive to you), to help enrich the lives of young girls, and have a great time doing it! The 'Recipe for Success' program is an abbreviated version of our year-long Girl Scouting experience, and will focus on supporting continued education and preventing learning loss. Activities proven to support financial management skills, STEM, and literacy are provided specifically through Girl Scout resources. Only 5 girls are needed to start a troop, and girls of multiple ages can participate in the same troop.

What is the cost?

Annual membership dues are \$15 per girl, and the corresponding Journey Book is \$7. Financial assistance is available for annual membership dues.

What is included?

You will have hands-on support from a Community Development Manager, and Girl Scouts program staff who will provide access to a number of curriculum and activity options. Members will participate in the internationally acclaimed Girl Scout Cookie Sale—an amazing way to learn financial literacy, entrepreneurship, and teamwork. Girls will be provided with an official Girl Scout Cookie pin, too!

What will be asked of me as a Leader?

You will chose the frequency of your troop meetings. To maximize the experience, Girl Scouts suggests meeting weekly, or every-other-week. You will have the ability to determine the schedule that works best for your troop. Leaders will typically commit 1-1.5 hours for each meeting session.

How do we get started?
