All the Women of the Bible-Deen shows how the women behind the Biblical stories are very much like the women of today. (220.9)

All the Women of the Bible-Mastro divides the book into a "book of Names" (dictionary) and a "book of stories" about 56 women whose lives were changed by crisis and challenge. (220.9)

Bible Women-Freeman identifies every woman who speaks in the Bible, providing their words, context, and historical background. (220.9)

A Faith of Her Own-Kalas focuses on women who were crucial to the story of the old testament and how their story can shape our lives today. (221.9)

Friendship of Women, The Hidden Tradition of the Bible-Chittister looks deeply into biblical stories of female friendship in order to extract greater truths. (241.6)

From Eve to Esther, Letting Old Testament Women Speak to Us-Moheny has written a study of 8 Old Testament women and the lessons they have for today's woman. (221.9)

Reading the Women of the Bible-Frymer-Kensky explores the experiences of women in a patriarchal society and the relevance of their stories to modern life. (221.9)

The Scarlet Cord-Hamilton adds detail and dialogue to brief accounts of 12 biblical women, allowing us to discover layers of meaning previously overlooked. (220.9)

Seeing Ourselves-Whitley gives powerful voice to the New Testament women who met Jesus before and after the Resurrection (225.9)

Speaking for Ourselves, Voices of Biblical Women-Whitley has written inspiring monologues in which the women of the bible speak in their own voices. (220.9)

Strong Was Her Faith-Kalas looks into the life and times of 11 women of the New Testament and how they shaped the New Testament story. (225.9)

Twelve Extraordinary Women-MacArthur looks into the lives of some of the Bible's women and shows how God continues to mold and use ordinary people today. (220.9)

Women in Scripture-Meyers has compiled 800 articles exploring all the women mentioned in the Bible. (220.9)

Women of the Bible-American Bible Society biographies introduce biblical heroines and show that the truths that were relevant to them then are still relevant to us today. (220.9)

Women of the Bible-Richards provides a guide to the Bible's women of faith, including both the women around Jesus and the common women of the Bible. (220.9)
