People Who Care has been helping enrolled Neighbors in Prescott and Chino Valley for over 23 years, and most recently, in the Prescott Valley and Dewey communities.

Volunteers provide one to one non-medical assistance to adults unable to drive due to physical or age related limitations who are living on their own with limited or no family support.
