REQUIREMENTS

MD, DO, or MD/PhD degree with clinical training in an oncologic discipline. May be completing a residency and/or fellowship, depending on the discipline. Interest and training in clinical trials and/or laboratory based research. Intent to focus on translational research leading to a clinical trial. Willingness to participate in didactic training in clinical and translational research, to publish and author clinical trials. Minimum of a 2-year commitment required.

MENTORING FACULTY

Mentoring provided by nationally recognized basic, clinical, and translational faculty at Case Western Reserve University and University Hospitals Case Medical Center.
