

## Washington Timbers FC begin construction of turf fields at Harmony

Washington Timbers Football Club is moving forward with its new \$1.8 million lit turf field project. Construction is scheduled to start immediately and is expected to be completed this summer.

The fields will be located at the home of Washington Timbers FC, Harmony Sports Complex. The new fields will be constructed with artificial turf and will take the place of the grass fields on the South end of the Complex. The fields are part of an overall effort by the Washington Timbers to improve its physical campus and the product it can deliver to the members of its Club.

Technical Director Brett Jacobs is thrilled. "Our vision is to provide a best in class soccer organization that excels in player development through excellent coaching, innovative programs, premium facilities, our development philosophy and providing a fun learning environment.
