What is the ME* Competition?

The ME* Competition is a program designed to recognize student achievement in acquiring and applying knowledge in economics, entrepreneurship, and personal finance.

Who are the competitors?

Four-member teams

Newark: Grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 - **2 teams** per grade level

Georgetown: Grades 3, 4 and 5 - **3 teams** per grade level

Teams must be accompanied by an adult.

How does the ME* Competition work?

Each team participates in 3 events. The events are:

PRODUCTION: Each team assembles products in a given amount of time.

TEST: Each team takes a written test on basic economic concepts.

PROBLEM SOLVING: Each team designs a product to solve a given problem, creates an advertising campaign, and makes a two-minute presentation before a panel of judges.
