Individual Leadership

Heads of Schools need to feel responsible to:

- Pursue Montessori Ed.
- Network with other Ed. Systems
- Provide novices with opportunities to lead projects (various areas)
- Participate in programs (i.e. NAEYC resulting in 5 starts (QRIS))
- Important to be open to many types of leadership

Strategies:

- Communication within a school of available opportunities, and the freedom to pursue own areas of interest
- Opportunity to share knowledge with others
- Becoming part of organizations (i.e. OMA Board)
- Support for staff to continue ed. (through classes, workshops, etc.)

Challenges:

- Difficult to "quantify" a lot of Montessori work
- Difficult to assess a young child academically because they are process-oriented
