- 1. **The Town's Consumer Confidence Report** -CCR report is currently being drafted by ASRWWA and should be ready shortly. It is information of our drinking water system based largely on Woonsocket's CCR and as requested by regulatory bodies. It will be distributed to all the required locations. Maura Beck our water and sewer administrator will submit to RI Drinking Water Quality as soon it is received so no problem making the October deadline. We are right on target for that.
- 2. **Complaints that are being received by Zoning** are being dealt with on a case by case basis. Anonymous complaints do not have the same priority as those who go in to the office and explain the issue or call in to work toward a resolution. Please encourage any residents to file formally.
- 3. **The Memorial Day Parade is Monday**. Step off at 10:30 at Slatersville Plaza. Ceremony at Town Hall at 11:15.
- 4. **June 11, 9:30- 11:30, there will be a Town Charrette** to discuss the boundaries of the new national park in Slatersville. NPS staff will be there. Please join us! Scout's Municipal Hall, 13 Main St.
- 5. **RIPTA is considering removing Slatersville** as a drop off and pick up. Low ridership. We are working with them for a park and ride at the plaza to help that. If you ride the bus, let us know!
- 6. We have an analysis of options for the street light purchase. Mr. Dash, our energy consultant is reviewing a variety of funding option and will make a recommendation. Significant savings will be realized.
- 7. **If you serve on a board or commission** or can encourage others, we are required to have minutes posted within 35 days from the meeting date.
- 8. **The water and sewer budget is being** reviewed by Mr. Pendergast and Mr. Carpenter. Should have some recommendations sewer commission made some last week- to keep us on the right track.
- 9. **The Town Council has entered into arbitration** with the City of Woonsocket concerning the Contract for waste water services. Many, including myself, would encourage a quick resolution as the people of North Smithfield will be in dire straits when the services end in November of 2016.
