Description

This course is packaged with other courses. To study this course, you must apply for the CIII in Early Childhood Education and Care and Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care.

This course is for people who want to work as an early childhood educator in a centrebased service or family day care. This level of educator is responsible for planning, implementing and managing programs in early childhood education and care services in accordance with legislative requirements and is often responsible for the supervision of others.

You will gain skills and knowledge in how to use a national learning framework, regulations and quality standards to support the education and care of children from birth to school age. You will be able to document, plan and evaluate children's play and learning while ensuring children's health and safety. You will be able to support the holistic development of children birth to school age and manage a children's service to address regulations and quality assurance.

Workers in this role may have responsibility for supervision of volunteers or other staff.

Course

Certificate 3 in Early Childhood Education and Care (Course No. 25272) is not a mandatory pre-requisite. However many students choose to package the Certificate 3 in Children's Services (Course No. S25272) with the Diploma so that they can find employment in the sector on completion of the Certificate 3.

PACKAGE Delivery Pattern: Students applying for the Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (1.5 years) will complete 25272 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (0.5 year) + 25281 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (1 year). Academic IELTS 5.5 required for entry to packaged Diploma.

If you are seeking to enrol in a First Aid unit of competency you are advised that to complete the unit you must be able to perform basic life support skills, for example perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). If you have a disability that would prevent you from performing required basic life support skills you are advised that you will not be able to achieve the unit of competency.

A Working With Children Check is compulsory.

Work placement

Workplace learning ('on-the-job' training), is required for the achievement of competencies in the Diploma. A minimum of 300 hours of workplace learning is required, comprising 240 hours in a real workplace (over 2 semesters) and 60 hours of simulated in-class activity. Workplace learning is not paid. A teacher will secure a work placement for you and assist in the organisation of the workplace learning and associated workplace activities in line with TAFE NSW policy.

A Working With Children Check is compulsory.

Additional information

In NSW you need a minimum of one year's experience, gained after the Diploma qualification, to apply for the role of an authorised supervisor of a child care centre. See the Trades Recognition Australia (TRA) requirements.
