
Interactive Orals in Ms. Estrada's Class

11th grade students in Mrs. Estrada's DP Literature course initiated their required Interactive Oral Group Presentation for *Chronicle of a Death Foretold* by Gabriel Garcia Marquez. As part of their study of works in translation, all 11th grade students are required to initiate one IOGP and participate in the remaining two presentations. Students researched the culture and context of Marquez's novel and planned a lesson to teach and engage their fellow classmates with the content in order to enhance their understanding of the novel. All of the groups did an excellent job of engaging their classmates through creative presentations that included dramatic reenactments of historical events and situations, an interview with student Cana Rollin's grandmother who lived in the same region of Colombia as Marquez, and an interactive concept web that visually represented the various connections between aspects of culture, context, and the text. The groups for each class delivered three distinct presentations, but as was evident in their reflective statements, students in every class learned a considerable amount about the cultural and contextual considerations in *Chronicle of a Death Foretold*.
