This exciting yet physically challenging camp is designed for campers going into 4th-8th grade. Campers travel a two mile radius on their bicycles from Lacy Park to local areas of interest including the San Marino High School pool, food and snack places, and the arcade. Cyclists receive bike safety lessons from experienced Recreation Staff and guidance from the San Marino Police Department. Bike safety literature and other enforcements are also provided. Swimming, weekly excursions are included with the weekly registration. All campers must pre-register at the Recreation Office. Campers are required to know how to ride a bike and bring their own bikes, helmets, locks, and safety vests. Safety vests can be purchased for \$6 through the Recreation Department.

Lunch Ride

The Lunch Ride program is designed for students attending summer school who are registered in any of our recreation camps or summer classes at Lacy Park, the Recreation Department, or Jr. Titan Sports Camps. Upon dismissal from school, students meet Recreation Staff at the school's lunch court and board a safety-certified bus for transportation to Lacy Park and other programs. Activities are provided at school until approximately 1 pm when camp and classes begin. Please note that each child must bring his/her own packed lunch. All participants are escorted by Recreation Staff to their respective programs. All participants must pre-register at the Recreation Office.
