- Bio-hazardous materials
- Personal care products (shampoo, lotion, etc.)
- Household hazardous waste (paint, cleaners, batteries)

- Expired & unwanted prescription medications
- Veterinary medications
- Over-the-counter medications
- Medicated liquids, creams, ointments
