This is a one day event to be held on Saturday, May 2, 2015 at the Public Works Garage drop site, 649 S. Main Street, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Items that will be accepted:

- Televisions - all types
- VCR-DVD-Blue Ray players
- Laptop computers*
- Desk top computer* with monitor, keyboard, mouse (considered one unit)
- Printers (no upright office units), scanners
- Stereos, record players, radios, speakers, reel to reel, 8-track and cassette players and peripherals
- Telephones, cell phones*, electronic cameras
- Counter top microwave ovens



LIMIT OF TWO ITEMS FOR EACH CATEGORY

RULES:

Village residents only! Pre-registration to utilize this service is required. Register at Village Hall, 639 E. Green Bay Ave., no later than May 1st. Registered participants will be issued a validated pass. One pass per address. Passes will be collected at the drop site. *Anyone arriving at the site without a valid pass will be denied access to the service.*
