



### Columbia St. Mary's School-based Oral Health Program

We are pleased to announce Smart Smiles, Columbia St. Mary's school-based oral health program, in partnership with the Ozaukee County Public Health Department, will be providing preventative dental services to Ozaukee County students at the **Feith Family Ozaukee YMCA -- August 3-7, 2015 from 8:30am – 2:00pm**

Dental services include screening, oral health instruction, fluoride, sealants, and possible referral for follow up care. Students will also receive a goody bag which contains a new toothbrush, toothpaste, pencil, and sugar free bubble gum. All children entering grades K5-8<sup>th</sup> are eligible for treatment, and there is no charge to you or your child's school for Smart Smiles services.

The goal of the Smart Smiles program is to reduce the incidence of untreated decay by increasing the number of children who have access to preventative oral health services. Dental Sealants are a proven way to avoid future cavities and pain. Smart Smiles services are encouraged for those without an established dental home. Treatment received in the program is not intended to be an alternative to routine dental care. Please seek diagnosis and follow up care with a dentist, especially if additional treatment is recommended by Smart Smiles staff.
