



Update on Public Works Projects

February 2016

The city is growing and so is the traffic. On Peachtree Parkway (State Route 141) alone, the traffic count is expected to increase from its current 42,000 vehicles a day to 50,000 in just five years.

The city's Public Works Department is studying various options for this busy corridor along with other major arteries in our community. Currently, studies and projects include:

- Widening Peachtree Parkway (S.R. 141) southbound at its merge with Peachtree Industrial Boulevard (PIB), which will create two lanes merging into PIB from the existing one lane. The widening will begin just south of Holcomb Bridge Road.
- New sidewalks on Technology Parkway from S.R. 141 to Westech Drive have begun. Sidewalks on both sides of the street will be added to this section of the road.
- The city's first Public Works project on Winters Chapel Road is now complete. Sidewalks, street furniture and two pedestrian crosswalks have been added to this busy road.
- Intersection and pedestrian safety improvements are under design at Peachtree Corners Circle at Eastman Trail and at Peachtree Corners Circle at Medlock Bridge Road.
- Reconfiguring of the Jimmy Carter Boulevard/Holcomb Bridge Road intersection is under design. Construction is expected to begin this summer.
- A study to consider installing constant flow intersections along Peachtree Parkway to improve traffic flow is underway, including an assessment of traffic and congestion improvement opportunities at S.R. 141 at these four intersections: East Jones Bridge Road, Forum Drive, Peachtree Corners Circle and Spalding Drive.
- Studies to add pedestrian crossings for Winters Chapel Road and E. Jones Bridge Road is underway.
- The city's first resurfacing program is scheduled to kick off in February, which will repave several of the worst rated streets. Another section of streets is scheduled for resurfacing this summer.
- AT&T will continue installing new fiber optic lines in the rights-of-way throughout the city.
