All candidates for superintendent licensure must complete an internship.

A minimum 320 hours of internship working directly with a licensed and practicing superintendent is required for licensure. All hours must be

completed within a 12 continuous month time period. This program has been designed to meet the Minnesota Competencies identified in MN Rule 3512.2500, as well as the Interstate School Leaders Licensure Consortium (ISLLC) and ELLC competencies.

The field experience is designed to provide experiences that enhance knowledge and develop skills for future educational leadership. This program will prepare the intern for leadership roles in PK-12 schools.
