




**Art League Endowment Fund**

Jan Bain, artist in residence at the Art League of Ocean City, is embarking on a new project for families. "How does Your Garden Grow" is a series of free Saturday workshops, beginning October 17, from 10 to 12. With the help of grants from the PNC Foundation and the Gannett Foundation, the classes hope to inspire families to appreciate the environment, eat healthy things, and paint the beautiful flowers. The classes will feature experts in their fields, for example: a musician, a potter, a vegetarian gourmet cook, and a man who raises Monarch butterflies. The culminating project will be creating a butterfly garden and having a community celebration. In August the participants will release the butterflies they have raised.

After retiring, from being a teacher, a principal, a school administrator, and a librarian, Jan began taking her art seriously. Although she still thinks of herself as a beginner, she has become a successful watercolor artist. She can be found several days a week in Studio B at the Center for the Arts, painting and greeting visitors. Her enthusiasm has led her to create programs at the Millsboro Art League and the Ward Museum. She also teaches English several days a week at Delaware Technical Community College. Jan paints every day and lives her message: "Love the earth; enjoy the art."
