Attendance will be taken in the Virtual Lab every period and every day by the lab facilitator.		
 Students will be marked present/tardy/absent just as any other face to face class. Students are expected to work on their online class during this time

Students taking online courses off campus will be scheduled for these classes during either 1st or 6th period.		
 With parent/guardian permission, student may arrive at a later time or leave at an earlier time than th typical arrival and dismissal times of the school. It is the responsibility of the student and his/her parents or guardians to provide transportation and t arrange timely pick up from and drop off for school. 		
Students being dropped off after the start of the school day must report to their class on time. No excuse absences will be given for arriving to school late.	d	
 Students must follow all school check in and check out procedures. Students are not permitted to loiter on campus during these respective periods and may face disciplinar consequences for loitering. Ex: if a student is taking an online class off campus 6th period, the studen should leave campus at the end of 5th period. If a student is taking an online class off campus in 1st period he/she should arrive to school in time for 2nd period to start. 	nt
