The brainchild of former Royal Ballet principal dancers, Michael Nunn and Billy Trevitt, **BalletBoyz** was founded in 2001.

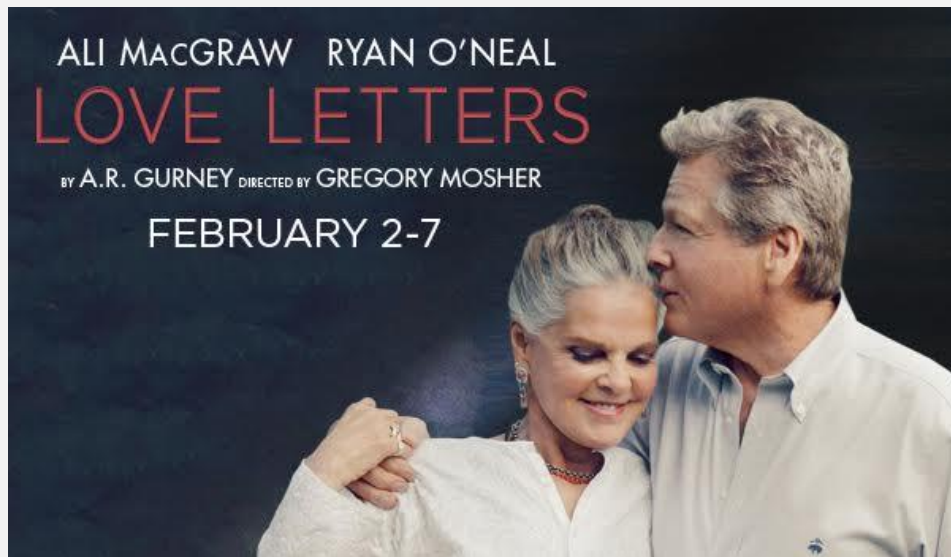
An all-male company of ten dynamic dancers, BalletBoyz is one of the most original and innovative forces in modern dance, celebrated for its energy and grace.
