## Call to Artists

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Art On the Divide Invitational Art Show**

**Historic Georgetown, Ca.**

**Show dates, Sept. 2-25, 2016**

*El Dorado County hosts the World Gold-Panning Championships, Sept. 11-18th. Join in the fun as history is re-enacted.*

#### About the Show

Gold Fever strikes the Divide and El Dorado County. Art On the Divide Gallery invites artists to submit art depicting the life and times during the Gold Rush Era.

A committee of artists from the gallery will jury in the pieces to display. A "People's Choice" award will be recognized by a ribbon at the end of the show.

#### Submission of Artwork

All mediums will be accepted. Art must be original design and for sale. Reproductions or giclees will not be accepted.

Two-dimensional artwork should be no larger than 24x36 inches. Three dimensional artwork is limited to 40lbs and a 2x2 foot maximum footprint. All 2-d artwork must be under glass (Plexiglas, if shipped) with the exception of oil or acrylic. Gallery wrap is acceptable for oil, acrylic and photography. Artwork must be properly framed and wired for hanging. Saw-tooth hangers cannot be accepted. All sculpture or 3-d pieces must be securely attached to a base.

All artwork must be clearly labeled with artist's name, title of work, medium and sales price.

#### Entry Fees and Deadlines

Early Bird Deadline is July 31<sup>st</sup>. 1<sup>st</sup> entry is \$10.00 and each additional is \$5.00 (up to 3 maximum).

Final Deadline is August 8<sup>th</sup>. 1<sup>st</sup> entry is \$20.00 and each additional is \$5.00 (up to 3 maximum)

#### Submission of Entry Form

Entry form and jpeg pictures of artwork may be submitted via email, AODCgallery@gmail.com. It is preferable to submit in jpeg format (300 dpi). Alternately, submit a 4x6 photograph or jpeg file on CD. Photos and CD's will be returned only upon request.

Checks for entry to be payable to AODC Gallery, P.O. Box 184, Georgetown, Ca. 95634. Entries must be postmarked by deadlines indicated.

Applicants will be notified by mid-August. AODC Gallery will receive 20% commission on all sales during the show, please price your art accordingly. California sales tax will be added to all sales. All art considered for the show must be available for sale during the show.

Accepted artwork should be delivered to AODC Gallery, 6295 Main Street, Georgetown, on Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> or 27<sup>th</sup> between 11-4. Artists should pick up any unsold artwork on Sept. 28<sup>th</sup> between 9 and 12. Artwork must be displayed for the duration of the show. Arrangements need to be made ahead of time if someone other than the artist is to pick up or deliver art.

#### Artist Reception

AODC will host an artist reception on September 10<sup>th</sup> in conjunction with Divide Gold Rush Days. Time TBA. Please save the date!

Art On the Divide Gallery will take the greatest possible care of all artwork, although we will not be responsible for loss or damage of any work. Artists are responsible for their own insurance.
