Public Allies believes that everyone has leadership potential and assets to contribute towards making a difference in their community. We show young leaders how to turn their passions, experiences, and commitment to making a difference in their community into a viable career path. Each year we identify people of widely diverse backgrounds to join our 10-month apprenticeship program. Public Allies program includes:

Full-time, apprenticeships in local a nonprofit organization. Apprentices help nonprofits by contributing their skills and experience to help improve and expand their capacity. Organizations are able to serve more people and have a greater impact. We work with organizations that are focused on a variety of issues, including youth development, education, health, economic development, the arts and the environment. We provide a weekly leadership development curriculum delivered by community leaders. Public Allies AmeriCorps apprentices are eligible for:

- A monthly living allowance of \$1,500.
- Health care insurance, child care assistance, and interest-free student loan deferment.
- An education award of \$5,645 after successfully completing the program to pay back student loans or pay for future education.
