The Family & Youth Services Bureau (FYSB), Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention (APP) Program, is actively recruiting new reviewers to support the review and evaluation of federal grant applications submitted for the Competitive Personal Responsibility Education Program (C-PREP) and Competitive Abstinence Education (CAE) Program. C-PREP grants provide funding for projects that aim to educate youth on abstinence and contraception for the prevention of pregnancy, sexually transmitted infections, and HIV/AIDS. CAE grants provide funding to projects emphasizing evidenced-based and or effective abstinence education strategies that reduce teen pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections.

Qualifications:

- Must be a Professional with human services or public health experience, to include program work in at-risk youth and/or crisis intervention, or a student pursuing a degree in a public health or human services.
- Must have a strong understanding of evidence-based programming.
- Must have organizational and time management skills.
- Must be able to analyze and evaluate complex materials.
- Must have comprehensive writing skills.
- Must be comfortable participating in a virtual team environment.
- Must be available to participate in mandatory training webinars.
- Must have the ability to effectively utilize the internet and web-based technology.
- Must be fluent in writing and speaking in English.

Tools Required:

- Email

- Adobe Acrobat or other PDF reader

Level of Commitment:

- Participate in approx. three (3) mandatory training sessions.
- Devote 6-8 hours daily over a period of 5 consecutive days to read, evaluate and score applications.
- Devote 3-4 days for panel consensus discussion, if necessary.
- Be available a minimum of 4 hours between 9am (EST) and 5pm (EST) for the consensus discussions.
