Horizons' hands-on approach instills a love of learning and the academic and social skills essential to becoming responsible, contributing citizens. Additionally, Horizons makes a long-term commitment to each student and family. Programming will eventually go through eighth grade.

Horizons seeks professional, caring individuals with the ability to help implement strategies to engage students in active learning through non-traditional ways. Responsibilities:

- Teach 15 students (rising K-7th grade) during a five-week summer enrichment program.
- Implement creative, engaging classes that support the students' academic needs.
- Work in partnership with teaching assistant and high school intern.
- Provide verbal and written feedback to students and their families.
- Participate in field trips and other enrichment experiences, including swimming program (as needed).
- Attend a two-day orientation session prior to the start of the program and one day wrap-up.
- Make phone calls to class prior to program beginning.
- Attend staff gatherings/trainings prior to program beginning.
