## Serving Transgender Clients

## OVERVIEW

The purpose of this webinar is to increase participants' knowledge around working with transgender and gender non-conforming clients. Transgender individuals are at extreme risk for a variety of family planning related health issues, yet are very unlikely to seek medical assistance due to misinformation and fear of prejudice. Participants in this session will learn how to make their organizations safe and welcoming to this population.

## TOPICS

- Define transgender and other gender identity related terms
- Explain the hardships faced by transgender communities, particularly within clinical settings
- Identify ways to change environments to make spaces safer for this population
- Allow for honest questions that clinicians have for serving transgender clients
