**7pm:** Bonfire started. Bring something to roast over the bonfire or just sit and enjoy.

Saturday Morning: Yoga on the Beach with Melanie Newton. Please bring a yoga mat and beach towel.

11am: Brunch, bring your own drink and a brunch item to share. There will be an award given for the best Summer Sailstice hat. We are planning to take a group picture to send to Summer Sailstice..

**2pm**: **Team sailboat building, followed by a regatta.** Teams will be drawn at 2pm. **Please sign up by June 12**<sup>th</sup> **on the attached form**, we need to figure out what supplies to bring.
