Here's a few of the scheduled activities for Summer Sailstice

Remember: You can join in on all the activities, one or two activities, or nothing at all and just enjoy the beach.

Friday at 5pm: Wine tasting. Bring a bottle of wine. Please let Mary know the varietal beforehand. You will be divided up by varietal for the tasting. More information on Wednesday night.

5:45pm: Happy Hour, bring your own drink and an appetizer to share.

7pm: Bonfire started. Bring something to roast over the bonfire or just sit and enjoy.

Saturday Morning: Yoga on the Beach with Melanie Newton. **Please bring a yoga mat and beach towel.**

11am: Brunch, bring your own drink and a brunch item to share. There will be an **award given for the best Summer Sailstice hat**. We are planning to take a group picture to send to Summer Sailstice..

2pm: Team sailboat building, followed by a regatta. Teams will be drawn at 2pm. **Please sign up by June 12th on the attached form**, we need to figure out what supplies to bring.

5pm: Summer Sailstice Drink Contest (no, that's not a drinking contest – it's a recipe contest!) The top two (or three) winning recipes (depending on how many drinks are entered) will receive prizes. So, set your sails and start experimenting to come up with a special Summer Sailstice Drink. Be creative and give it a name. Maybe it could be called *Rum Sunrise/Sunset* (in honor of the longest day of daylight for the year). You decide. **Please sign up on the attached form by June 12th** and send me your drink name. Please write down your recipe and give to me, before the contest begins. Please let me know if you are going to help judge the drinks, you must sign up by **June 12th**. (If you are entering a drink, you still can judge as well.)

5pm: Happy Hour. Bring over an appetizer to share (and whatever you want to drink). This will be going on at the Same time as the drink contest. I hope you sign up to bring a drink and/or be a judge.

7pm: Stone Soup is served! (Bring something to add around 5pm. Please no seafood or cabbage, we will only have 1 pot.)

8pm: Limbo hook. Limbo under the boat hook to tropical music. Prize to the winner.
