



Student Bus Contract

It is a privilege for a student to ride on the Cornerstone school bus. It is the responsibility of both the driver and student to do everything possible to make it a safe ride. The privilege of a student to ride a school bus is based on contingent observation of safety rules and acceptable behavior.

1. Waiting students must allow all students to exit the bus before they begin boarding. Please enter and exit the bus in an orderly manner.
2. All electronics should be stowed away during the ride.
3. Boys and girls do not sit together on the bus (in the same seat).
4. Be respectful towards everyone both verbally and physically.
5. The driver is in full charge of the bus and students. The driver will assign seats and students must sit in the assigned seat and face forward during the entire bus ride.
6. If the bus is in movement do not walk or run toward the bus. Approach the bus once it has come to a complete stop.
7. Do not walk or run toward the bus if you miss it. Return to the building and tell an adult you missed the bus. If a student misses the bus, parents will be notified.
8. Students are responsible for the area in which they sit. No food or drinks on the bus.
9. Unnecessary conversation with the driver is prohibited. Classroom noise level and behavior are the expected standards on a bus.
10. To prevent injury, do not place objects, heads, hair or hands out of bus windows.
11. Students must sit in their seats facing forward. All aisles, emergency exits and stairwells must be kept clear at all times this includes students and/or objects.
12. To prevent injury and driver distractions, passengers are not allowed to stand or move around while the bus is in motion.
13. Aggressive behavior toward the driver or other passengers is unsafe and prohibited.
14. No glass containers, balloons, or insects of any kind are allowed on the bus.
15. Throwing, spitting, kicking or shooting items inside the bus or out the windows is hazardous and prohibited.
16. Student will pay for any damage caused by the student to the bus.

I have read the bus rules and understand them. I know that if I choose not to follow these rules, I will be given a school bus discipline referral which if warranted may result in immediate suspension of riding privileges.

I understand that school administrators and transportation personnel are responsible to enforce consistent bus policies. My signature below indicates I understand the school bus rules and consequences I face, if I choose not to follow them. I understand and agree to follow the rules.
