YOU WILL NEED:

- *Pictures of your student during each year of his or her life from kindergarten to eighth grade. Plus, one baby picture of your choice. They do not have to be school pictures; any picture from that general age will do!*
- *Blue poster board (provided). **
- *Black construction paper to mat pictures (provided). **
- *White paper for captions (provided).*
- *Adhesive or glue*
- *Scissors or paper cutter*

**Please only use the provided materials. We would like the displays to maintain a uniform atmosphere.*

The template on the back shows the required format for your display.

- *Posters should be in “**portrait**” format (length-wise/vertical). *
- *All pictures should be matted onto black paper with approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ ” to $\frac{1}{2}$ ” around all sides.*
- *Leave 6” at the top blank. We will put your student’s name in that spot.*
- *Write or type a caption for each picture. (i.e., “This is Rose in first grade.” “This is Rose at the zoo in fifth grade with her little brother.”)*

Please retrieve your student’s display at the end of the graduation ceremony on June 13th. We are excited to celebrate with you!
