



# NEW TRAINING FOR CLERGY WHO WANT TO BECOME DISASTER CHAPLAINS

Disaster Chaplaincy Services (DCS) is calling on ordained clergy interested in providing spiritual care to those affected in times of disaster. Please consider joining our corps of volunteer chaplains.

DCS is a multi-faith, multicultural, multilingual organization that assures skilled and appropriate spiritual care for all people affected by disasters in the New York tri-state area. Established in 2001 prior to our nation's September 11th tragedy, DCS is the only organization in the New York City region whose chaplains are directly deployed alongside the Red Cross, New York City's Office of Emergency Management and other recognized agencies.

Volunteer disaster chaplains must be ordained clergy from recognized denominations, willing to work with and respect people of all faiths, those questioning and those with no faith tradition. All chaplains must sign a code of ethics that includes refraining from proselytizing, sermonizing, and must be willing to provide non-discriminatory spiritual care to all regardless of nationality, race, religion, belief, gender expression, class, or sexual orientation.
