We are grateful to report that Reb Zalman and Eve were in LA during the deluge, and were personally unhurt - though their home suffered major damage and Reb Zalman's Rabbinical Office, Meeting Room and Prayer Room will have to be entirely reconstructed and refurnished quickly so that his and Eve's health is not compromised by mold.
