



REGISTRATION OPENS WEDNESDAY, MARCH 16TH AT 12:00 PM

Welcome to the Spring Session of the Lafayette Enrichment Program (LEP)! Below, please find detailed descriptions (including day, time and pricing) of the classes being offered through LEP for the **SPRING SESSION**. This session will run for 8 weeks, **APRIL 11 – JUNE 3**. Classes run from 3:30-4:30 unless otherwise stated. Although this is an 8 week session, due to holidays certain classes have less than 8 classes. The number of weeks for each class noted within the class description.

Once you've selected your classes, please visit our [online registration](#) site, March 16th at 12:00 PM to register your child. Registrations are accepted on a first come-first served basis unless there is a lottery for a specific class. **We will have an enrollment lottery for the following classes: C3 Cyberclub classes, Lego Robotics, Cooks with Books, Tippi Toes, and Mad Science. Enrollment will open Wednesday at noon, and these popular classes will register straight to the waitlist. The lottery will remain open until 12:00 AM on March 17th, after which the enrollment system will execute a lottery for each of these classes, and students who get a place in the lottery will be notified the morning of March 17 (after 9AM). These recipients are allocated at least 48 hours to remit payment as confirmation of whether they can take the place, after which time the space may be offered to the next student in the lottery wait list.**

All classes are subject to minimum and maximum enrollment and early registration is strongly encouraged.

Once a class is filled to capacity, registrants (for non-lottery classes) will be placed on a *waitlist*. If a space becomes available, registrants will be notified by email and have 2 days to respond and pay for their space in the class. Students should confirm their desire to enroll in the class. If no response is received, the space in the class will be offered to the next person on the waitlist.

Payment may be made via credit card during enrollment. Full payment is due at the time of enrollment.

Minecraft Programming Using LUA

Using a custom mod called "Computercraft", students will learn how to program robots called "Turtles" inside the world of Minecraft. Kids will utilize problem-solving skills by learning how to program their robots to complete various tasks such as programming their turtles to automatically build, mine, and craft items and structures. They will be introduced to programming if-then-else statements, for-while loops, and implement their own functions using LUA, a simple scripting language. Looking for a fun way to introduce your child to programming? Why not do it using a game they love!
