

Welcome to the Winter Session of the Lafayette Enrichment Program (LEP)! Below, please find detailed descriptions (including day, time and pricing) of the classes being offered through LEP for the **WINTER SESSION**. This session will run for 8 weeks, **JANUARY 25**—

REGISTER BEGINNING DECEMBER 17[™], 6 AM

Once you've selected your classes, please visit our <u>online registration</u> site, December 17th at 6AM to register your child. This session we are trying a new registration time, as well as some new registration procedures.

Registrations are accepted on a first come-first served basis unless there is a lottery for a specific class. Starting with the 2016 Winter Session, we will have an enrollment lottery for the following classes: C3 Cyberclub classes, Lego Robotics, Drama Club, and Mad Science. Students who get a place in the lottery will be notified the morning of December 18th (after 9AM), and are allocated at least 48 hours to remit payment as confirmation of whether they can take the place, after which time the space may be offered to the next student in the lottery wait list. All classes are subject to minimum and maximum enrollment and early registration is strongly encouraged.

Once a class is filled to capacity, registrants (for non-lottery classes) will be placed on a waitlist. If a space becomes available, registrants will be notified by email and have 2 days to respond and pay for their space in the class. Students should confirm their desire to enroll in the class. If no response is received, the space in the class will be offered to the next person on the waitlist.

Payment may be made via credit card during enrollment. Full payment is due at the time of enrollment.

Using Unreal4®

Aspiring game designers will love this class as they have the chance to learn how to utilize the industry-standard game design software Unreal® Editor, used to create games as Batman: Arkham Asylum® and Mass Effect 3®. Students will learn how to create exterior environments, and apply different procedures of modeling and texturing. Students create their own outdoor terrain using advanced tools such as terrain sculpting, particle creation, and dynamic lighting. Entrepreneurship

We offer a project-based, commercial entrepreneurial enrichment program for grades 4-5. Through the program, we seek to unleash a student's creativity, self-awareness and self-esteem, leadership capabilities and collaborative skills, as we take the students on a journey of discovery into the world of commercial entrepreneurship.

We know that teaching entrepreneurship goes far beyond the lemonade stand. Our program is based on a life skill set that will enhance the students throughout their lives no matter which educational or career path our students choose. We have named the skills the five I's: Inspiration; Ideation and problem solving; Interaction and collaboration; Innovation and creativity; and Initiative; and dubbed them the Entrepreneurial Engine.

Using the Entrepreneurial Engine as the mainstay for our program, we have handcrafted activities that augment and complement the curriculum standards taught in schools. At the conclusion of this enrichment program, each student, with the help of his/her student, collaborative team, will have, among other things:

- (a) developed an idea for a business that captured the team's imagination;
- (b) branded the business entity;
- (c) created a business and marketing plan using financial concepts, such as profit, expense, income, investment, per unit cost, income, and start-up costs, for a business conceived through the team's own initiatives using the five I's skill set; and
- (d) produced a videotaped pitch to attract start-up capital.
