

CITI Training – Study Team Requirements

The Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) is an online research-training portal hosted by the University of Miami. Thousands of universities across the country, and internationally, subscribe to CITI for their research training. If you move to another university, your CITI training transfers with you, just affiliate with your new institution and you will be alerted if any additional modules are required from your new home institution.

Here at FAU it is used as a convenient way to offer training for a variety of topics, including human subjects research, animal welfare and use, information privacy and security, good clinical practices (clinical trials), responsible conduct of research and a host of other research topics. This can get confusing. So please pay attention to what training you need to complete as part of your research. We are developing a new, more user-friendly webpage to help you navigate through the training offerings. So stay tuned.

Please note that as of Nov. 1, 2014, all CITI course offerings are on a three-year renewal cycle. This means that a refresher course will be due three years after you first complete a course.
