FAU Owl trainees have inquiring minds with research occurring at all levels at FAU, undergraduate, graduate, and post-doctoral. Here are some tips for getting your IRB protocol reviewed and approved in a timely manner:

- Work closely with your faculty mentor to resolve questions or concerns before contacting Research Integrity. Your faculty advisor is an experienced researcher who has likely encountered many of the ethical challenges and study design questions you may be facing.
- Review our website, which includes our FAQs, guidance documents and decision tools.
- Review policies appropriate for your research proposal. For instance, if your research involves 4th grade students, familiarize yourself with the policy: Research with Minors in their Educational Setting.
- Where appropriate, group projects may be proposed. For instance, students who have a short timeframe for research may wish to work as a group to design a multi-aim research protocol in which each person analyzes one research objective.
