The Frontier Culture Museum in Staunton is the venue for the 7th Annual Wine & Jazz Festival. The event features member wineries of the Shenandoah Valley Wine Trail and brews and entertainment from Blue Ridge Beverage and Blue Moon. Hours are 1:00 to 7:00 pm.

Festival admission includes a tour of the Museum and souvenir wine glass. Attendees must be 21 and present a valid ID at the gate. Tickets are \$16 in advance, \$20 at the door; Non-tasting \$10; Student \$9; Children 6-12 are \$6, 5 and under Free.

Wineries participating in the festival include Barren Ridge Vineyards, Blue Ridge Vineyard, Bluestone Vineyard, Cave Ridge Vineyard, CrossKeys Vineyards, Hunts Vineyard, Lexington Valley Vineyard, North Mountain Vineyard, Old Hill Cider, Ox-Eye Vineyards, Rockbridge Vineyard, Shenandoah Vineyards, Wicked Oak Farm & Vineyard and Wisteria Farm & Vineyard. They will be joined by a variety of food and craft vendors.

The American Frontier Culture Museum tells the story of the thousands of people who migrated to colonial America, and of the life they created here for themselves and their descendants. These first pioneers came to America during the 1600s and 1700s from communities in the hinterlands of England, Germany, Ireland, and West Africa.
