



The splendor of Lee Hall Mansion's beautiful grounds provides the setting for the 15th annual Summer Celebration Wine Festival from 11 am to 6 pm. The finest vintages from Virginia's best wineries will be available for tasting and purchase. Live music combines with exquisite food and unique crafts to make this one of the Peninsula's most popular events.

Wineries include Byrd Cellars, Fincastle Vineyard & Winery, Horton Vineyards, Lake Anna Winery, Mattaponi Winery, Mermaid Winery, Naked Mountain Winery, Rebec Vineyards and Saude Creek Vineyards. Joe's Day Off and the Rhythm Kings will provide the music.

The historic house will be open for touring during the festival. Built by prominent Warwick County agriculturalist Richard Lee in 1859, Lee Hall is the only surviving building designed in the Italianate

architectural style on Virginia's Lower Peninsula. The home's rich history illustrates the strategic importance of its location during the Civil War. It is conveniently located a short distance from I-64, Exit 247.
