

### The Unit Leaders Role?

The Unit Leader's role is critical to the success of the youth leader in implementing his/her goals.

The Unit Leader must approve the youth's application.

### How is the course setup?

The patrol (team) method is used extensively throughout the training. Patrols (Teams) are on their own to set up campsites, cook meals and carry out other activities without direct adult supervision. A Troop Guide (Team Guide) is assigned to each patrol (team) to advise and be a resource to the participants throughout the learning process. The Troop (Group) setting provides an opportunity for youth to practice the newly learned skills providing the home unit with improved effectiveness and enthusiasm from the youth leaders. Troop (Group) instructors will help guide this learning. The training guidelines and rules are the same for those found in the Scout Oath and Law, the Outdoor Code. Code. and other national and council practical procedures.

## Who can attend?

NYLT is for you if you're a **Boy Scout** who can answer **YES** to **All** of the following:

- You'll be 13 years old by May 22, 2016;
  - You will not be 18 years old before June 12, 2016.
  - You'll be at least a First Class Scout by April 1st, 2016;
  - You now hold or intend to hold a unit leadership position;
  - You have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills For Troops.
  - You are mature enough and responsible enough to spend 2 weekends camping with youth you've never met, with minimal adult supervision, and always live the Scout oath and law;
  - You agree to practice the skills you learn at NYLT when you return to your home unit.
- AND
- Your Unit Leader and parents agree and recommend you.

NYLT is for you if you're in **Venturing** and can answer **YES** to **All** of the following:

- You are at least 14 years old by May 22, 2016;
  - You will not be 21 years old before June 12, 2016.
  - You have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews.
  - You are mature enough and responsible enough to spend 2 weekends camping\* with others you've never met, with minimal adult supervision, and always live the Scout oath and law;
  - You agree to practice the skills you learn at NYLT when you return to your home unit;
- AND
- Your Unit Leader and parents agree and recommend you.

\* The Course leaders will work with you in advance if you do not have extensive camping skills.
