## AWARDS

**COMMUNITY LEADER AWARD** Presented to the Outstanding Non-Scouter who supports scouting within the Adirondack Foothills District.

**CUB SCOUT HERO AWARD** This award is presented to Den Leaders who surmount all the problems of running a den and keep Cub Scouts alive. Also, Webelos Leaders who show dedication in helping their den transition into Boy Scouts. Each recipient must have a minimum of one (1) year of service.

**CUB SCOUT SERVICE AWARD** This award is presented to a maximum of five (5) adults who have provided the most exceptional service to the Cub Program either as Cubmaster (Assistant), Webelos Leader (Assistant), Den Leader (Assistant), or Committee Members. Each recipient must have a minimum of three (3) years of service.

**HOMEFRONT COORDINATORS AWARD.** This award is presented to Unit Committee Members and other supporting members of the Cub Pack. These are dedicated people who work hard in supporting Scouting with much time and effort behind the scenes of their units. Each recipient must have a minimum of one (1) year of service.

**DISTINGUISHED TRAIL TO EAGLE COACH AWARD** For the Scout Leader with a minimum of three (3) years of service who most demonstrates excellence in the promotion of Advancement of Scouts on the Trail to Eagle.

**BOY SCOUT/VENTURING SERVICE AWARD** This award recognizes a maximum of five (5) adults who have provided the most exceptional service as Crew Advisors, Scoutmasters, Assistants and Committee Members to the Boy Scout program. Each recipient must have a minimum of three (3) years of service.

**SCOUT PROGRAM IMPACT AWARD** This is a Unit award presented to Packs, Troops, and Crews who excel in camping and take part in community and religious activities as well as district events which help to maintain the principles of Scouting in leadership training, program and service.
