Her speaking career began in 2005, when she was invited to be the opening speaker at the AA International Convention in Toronto, sharing her recovery story with 55,000 people. Since then, Angie has been a highly requested speaker, speaking in over 120 cities. Ms. Pepper's life experience, wisdom and dedication to giving back to others and the community are remarkable. She speaks from the heart. Her powerful story will touch your spirit, lift your soul and breathe hope into your life.

Angie knows hopelessness and addiction at its lowest level, where there was no place to go but to die on the streets of Cincinnati. On June 20th, 1991, Angie walked away from alcoholism and was introduced to 12 step work, which she has been actively involved in for the past 20 years. Sharing her story of recovery and transformation makes her heart sing and deeply touches the lives of everyone she meets. Through recordings of her talk, she is known and loved throughout the world.

Angie's accomplishments include international and national speaking engagements, local stand-up comedy, an established singing career and ongoing work as an addiction counselor with individuals experiencing drug addiction, homelessness and mental illness.
