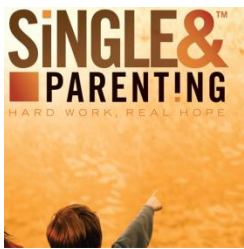

## Single & Parenting

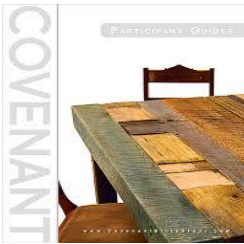
**Weeks 1 - 12**

## Living the Covenant

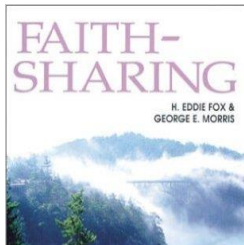
**Weeks 1 - 8**

## Faith Sharing

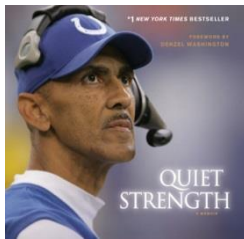
**Weeks 1 - 12**
