Our hospital submits this non-binding Letter of Intent to join the TORCH Community Care Organization ("CCO") as a founding member. This commitment is based on our organization's interest to actively participate in a collaborative TORCH-led population health initiative.

The TORCH CCO will function as a statewide clinically integrated network that offers care coordination/management services, evidence-based practice support and data analytics. In addition, the CCO will provide infrastructure and programming for members to participate in alternative payment arrangements such as value-based reimbursement with commercial payers and public/private shared savings programs.
