The Department for Diacony of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Hungary has a number of projects in place or under preparation with the aim of providing help and assistance to refugees.

All the project proposals on the list below are meant to serve a lasting purpose. This approach is necessary, since the refugee crisis in Europe is not likely to be solved in a day or two. This means that the financial contribution directly channeled into the rent of a storage facility for clothes also makes possible the use of that facility for other aid activities in the long run.

Another long-term result enabled by the contributions will be the enhanced ability of the church to respond in disasters, mobilize its resources and act immediately. All financial support received by the ELCH in this current situation, therefore, helps the establishment of disaster relief activities in the church, which will definitely be

<u>Objectives:</u> Creating inclusive communities; spreading awareness of the other culture through cuisine. Regular meetings for women, opportunities to prepare food together, increased familiarity with each other's culture through shared activity.
