Part-time Geriatric Medicine Fellowship Maine Medical Center in Portland, ME

MMC is seeking qualified candidates for the 2016-2018 fellowship year(s). Our well-rounded and rewarding training program provides flexibility for practicing physicians to complete a Geriatrics Fellowship, while still maintaining a presence in their own practices.

Our fully accredited part-time two-year Geriatric Medicine fellowship provides a supportive teaching environment with diverse experiences in office based practice, inpatient and hospital consult service, and off campus clinical sites at highly regarded nursing homes and assisted-living facilities.

Understanding that practicing physicians may have interests unique to their clinical situation, fellows will be able to design their clinical electives to meet these needs. With a primary care and hospitalist track, fellows may also choose what training schedule works best for them (2-3 days per week and/or concentrated multi-week blocks).

In addition to superb clinical experiences, we provide a well-rounded didactic curriculum including quality improvement projects, sessions on billing/coding/documentation and training in nursing home medical directorship. Fellows also have research opportunities and support for attending a regional or national Geriatric Medicine conference.

Subsidized housing (only 2 blocks from the hospital) is also available for those not based in the Portland area.
