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## **Top U.S. Nuclear Energy Industry, Government Leaders Converge at Global Markets Special Summit**

*Washington DC* – U.S. Acting Assistant Secretary of Energy for Nuclear Energy John Kotek and the Chairman of the U.S. House Science, Space and Technology Subcommittee on Energy Randy Weber (R-TX) will keynote a Special Summit on Global Nuclear Energy Markets on July 21-22 in Washington DC.

Summit headliners include former U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Commissioner Jeffrey Merrifield and U.S. Assistant Secretary of Energy emeritus Dr. Peter Lyons as well as industry keynotes by Westinghouse Electric Company, NuScale Power and GE Hitachi Nuclear Energy.

The Summit will also honor U.S. Senate Energy and Natural Resources Chairman Lisa Murkowski with the Council's Distinguished Leadership Award for contributions to energy security and nuclear energy policy.

Summit highlights include a special U.S. government experts panel featuring officials from the International Trade Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce, U.S. Department of State, National Nuclear Security Administration, Ex-Im Bank and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The Special Summit plenary features four regional global nuclear energy market assessments ranging from China, India and Asia to Great Britain and Europe to the Middle East, Africa, Canada and the Americas. Other Summit focuses encompass emerging opportunities including decommissioning; Fukushima D&D; and advanced reactors -- and an elements for success panel with key nuclear energy executives from CB&I, AECOM, Fluor and CH2M.
