Students should have at least 1 year of experience with their primary instrument.

SWING INTO JAZZ

At The Phoenix Conservatory of Music, **July 21- July 25**, For ages 13-17, Minimum of 5 students.

For the more advanced musician! Learn about the history of Jazz, get familiar with stylings and standards. Learn how to read charts, play melodies, learn about extended chord structures with non-standard voicings and get better at improvising.

Students should have at least 2 years of experience with their primary instrument.

AUDIO PRODUCTION POWERHOUSE

At The Phoenix Conservatory of Music, July 13- July 17, For ages 13-17, Minimum of 7 students.

For the more advanced musician! If you are interested in learning about how song writers write music, and how to write music yourself using music technology, this is the program for you! Come and learn how to use software like garage band and other cloud based learning tools, Logic Pro X, Pro Tools, audio production basics, and how to use those skills to write your own song using loops or original tracks.
