



Bike Challenge Statistics:

- 93,380 riders from across the country participated and biked 37,697,976 miles.
- The top rider was from Little Rock Arkansas who biked 32,882 miles during the challenge period. An average of 215 miles per day! (He was number 1 by a LOT)
- The top local area rider was Mary Catterton, who biked 10,722 miles. She was # 14 nationally and the top female rider in the nation.
- Wisconsin was the top state followed by Nebraska and Vermont
- Wisconsin had three communities of the top 5 in the nation;
 - Madison - #1
 - Appleton - #4
 - Milwaukee - # 5
- Wisconsin had 4 workplaces in the nation's top 10 (3M was # 1);
