dealing with domestic violence were given hope and healing.

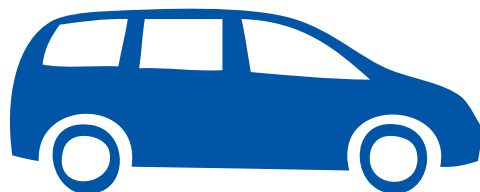
Nearly 1,000 students
